

Sound Collection: Old interface

Sound Collection: Updated interface with North Star design elements


The product designer and I created personas and journey maps to inform a North Star design. This screenshot shows the design elements that have shipped: an education band, featured music section, and quick picks for genre and music.



Sound Collection: In-product education for the user

An expandable/collapsible education band provides easily accessible information for users who may not be sure how and where they can use the audio. It also provides a fast link to terms of use for those who need legal copyright information.

Testing confirmed that the vertical space required for the Education Band was not detrimental to our topline metrics of daily average users or increased song downloads. So the education band was a helpful addition to the page.



Sound Collection: An updated heading that increased downloads by 3%

The featured music section was not performing as well as expected, so we experimented with different copy options. "Great music for your videos" produced a 3% increase in song downloads.
